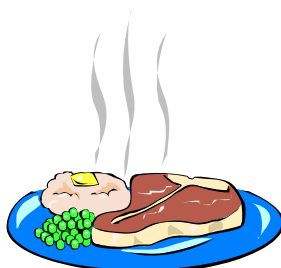

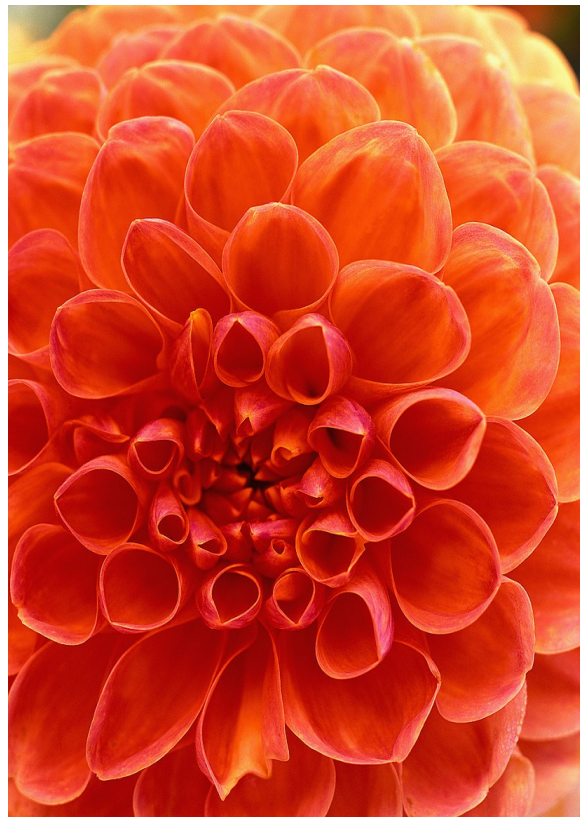
MEN'S CLUB "STEAK-OUT"
